Andy has been a featured soloist with many performing ensembles, including Wynton Marsalis and the Lincoln Center Jazz Orchestra. He has recorded with renowned artists Itzhak Perlman, Placido Domingo, Marilyn Horne and Frederica Von Stade, and appeared on numerous television programs, including *Late Night with David Letterman* and *Saturday Night Live*.

Andy is joined by pianist Conal Fowkes who has performed internationally, appearing on radio, television and film. He was a featured soloist in the Broadway show *One Mo' Time* and can be seen and/or heard in the films *Madame Suzatska*, *Ghost World*, *Finding Forester* and *The Aviator*.

A classical piano performance degree graduate who made his symphony debut at fourteen, Pandolfi's broader approach to the stage was shaped by several years working as the "piano guy" at major comedy clubs in L.A. where he was hired to interject musical interludes between sets by "up & coming" comedians including Jerry Seinfeld, Jay Leno, Robin Williams & others. After taking a strictly classical route with concert performances, he began to include popular repertoire and humor when he found that it removed barriers to response with audiences who seemed fearful of a piano "recital." Today, Pandolfi has become the industry's top-seller in his recording niche. (And while he'll still do a strict "recital" if you insist - you may have to stick a sock in his mouth to keep him serious and quiet between numbers.

From settings ranging from the Posh Feinstein's at the Regency in Manhattan to concert halls and university venues across the country, acclaimed Certified Steinway Artist Emile Pandolfi brings smiles, comforting familiarity and engaging warmth to every stage he plays. Satisfied, applauding patrons and invitations to return have become a standard accompaniment.

Performing celebrated works by Gershwin, Paganini, Liszt and his riotous rendition of *Flight of the Bumblebee*, marimbist and percussionist Greg Giannascoli is nothing less than astonishing. His virtuosity combines with his showmanship to create great artistry.

Greg was the winner of the Artist International New York Recital/Young Artist Competition and top prize winner of the Patrons of Wisdom International Young Artist Competition held in Toronto, Canada. He has performed as a soloist with orchestras and in recitals throughout North America, Europe and Asia and has delighted audiences on CBC, NPR radio and PBS TV.

Mr Giannascoli earned his DMA from Rutgers University, his MM from Virginia Commonwealth University and his BM from Rowan University. He currently gets to share his performing experience as a faculty member at the Julliard Pre-College and as the coordinator of the percussion department at New Jersey City University.
